## "In Office Sedation and General Anesthesia"

## **Course Description**

This lecture provides a structured framework for covering essential topics related to IV sedation and general anesthesia in a private practice dental office, ensuring that participants gain a comprehensive understanding of principles, techniques, safety considerations, and legal requirements.

## Learning Objectives

- Understand the differences between moderate sedation, deep sedation, and general anesthesia.
- Understand the differences between various sedation and anesthetic medications used.
- Recognize the importance of the preoperative evaluation and risk factors that preclude sedation/anesthesia in an office-based setting.
- Learn the anesthesia equipment brought by the anesthesia provider and safety protocols for office-based anesthesia.
- Learn the postoperative care and monitoring protocols in the post-anesthetic recovery period.
- Know the legal and regulatory considerations for Nitrous Oxide, IV Sedation and General Anesthesia.
